Dominique is a civil engineer graduated in Materials Science. He has an over thirty-fiveyear experience in the field of plastics for gas and water applications as an expert and project manager. His functional experience includes Resins Characterization, Pipes and Fittings Processing, Jointing Techniques, Aging, Test Methods, Thermomechanical Modelling, Non-Destructive Techniques, Standardization, Traceability Techniques.

During the period 1995-1998, Mr. Dominique GUEUGNAUT gave lectures (Aging of Polymers and Thermomechanical and Rheological Properties of Polymers during Processing) as an assistant professor (PAST) in a French Engineers school. Moreover, expert member of the European Gas Research Group (GERG) since 1987 and expert in several ISO standardization working groups (e.g., TC138/SC5), he was referee for specialized scientific journals and for several PhD committees (Ecole Polytechnique, Ecole des Mines de Paris) and author or co-author of over 120 publications and 10 patents.
